AIM Belgium has no objections against the activity if the following instructions are strictly adhered to.

General principles:

- Entering EBBR TMA is prohibited.
- Equipment:
The balloons shall be equipped with a working radio, manned by a trained operator. They shall maintain a listening watch on the appropriate frequency during the whole flight. The first and last balloon shall be equipped with a working transponder. If necessary, additional balloons carrying a transponder shall be positioned in the line of balloons at regular intervals.
- If the intention exists to land in a neighbouring country, an ICAO FPL shall be filed with Brussels ARO.
- The flight director shall send a list of all participating balloons to SPACC one workday on advance (before 15:00 LT) prior to the start of the meeting. This list shall contain:
 - Registration of the balloon
 - Pilot in command
 - Colours (and shape for shaped balloons)
 - Carriage of transponder or not

Any change hereto shall be communicated as soon as possible.

- Skeyes has the right to revise or withdraw this approval at any time.

Flight procedure:

- Preflight procedures
 - Minimum 30 minutes prior to planned lift-off the flight director shall contact Brussels ACC Supervisor by phone requesting lift-off.
 - Brussels ACC Supervisor shall:
 - Provide a transponder code;
 - Confirm frequency to be called after lift-off;
 - Confirm requested route or, if this is not feasible, propose an alternative;
 - Issue a level instruction in terms of “altitude”.
 - The organiser shall relay to Brussels ACC Supervisor which transponder code is allocated to which balloon.
- Lift-off procedures
 - The flight director shall contact Brussels FIC as soon as the first balloon is airborne.
- Landing procedures within CTR
 - The balloons shall announce their in initiation for final landing to Brussels FIC.
